## Invited Symposium

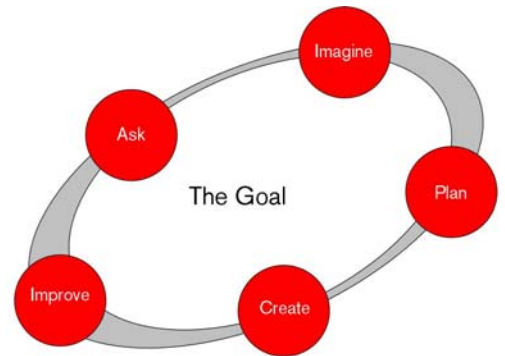
